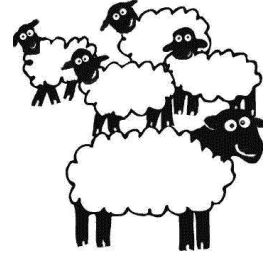


In The Skein Lane Loop
